Garnishment

A percentage of the
debtors wages are
taken

Execution of Seizure

Sheriff or Bailiff can
seize and sell
debtors assets

Alternative Dispute
Resolution

Negotiation

Simplest way to reach
an agreement

No third party required

Alternative Dispute Resolution

Mediation

- A neutral third party intervenes
- Parties do not have to accept mediator's decision



Civil Law

Alternative Dispute Resolution

Arbitration

- A neutral third party hears both sides of the case and makes a decision
- Decision is binding
