


## Rules of Static Electricity, Conservation of Electric Charge



- Rules of Static Charge: Like charges repel, unlike charges attract and charged objects attract neutral objects.
- 2. There are two types of charge, positive + and negative -.
- 3. Benjamin Franklin first assigned these charges to objects. He assigned the positive charge to a glass rod as a result of rubbing it with a cloth. His initial assignment was arbitrary but once it was set all other charge assignment was based on his initial assignment and the rules of static charge.
- 4. The Law of Conservation of Electric Charge states that the net amount of electric charge produced in any process is zero. That is one object gains while another loses charge.
