







One of the aspects of the program includes Construction Electrical

The focus of the program is the Carpentry component








Plumbing is also a part of the construction project that students are involved in.






Machining and Welding, although not related to construction, are also part of the TEx Program










After completing the TEx Program many of our students have moved on to apprenticeships in the trades:

machinery:








