Dear Parents, Guardians and Students,

Here are some important points of note as we head into the second week of January:

- New Lunch Break Routines: In order to avoid large congregations of students eating lunch in our hallways (which creates issues with mask use/non-use in close quarters with others), we are allowing students to eat in their Block 1 classrooms during the first 15min of the lunch hour so that students can eat and be without masks as a part of their cohort. This means that students will not be eating (and will have their masks on at all times) while in the hallways for the rest of the lunch hour (12noon -12:45pm). Students that don't have a Block 1 class on a particular day are encouraged to eat lunch at home before coming to school for their Block 2 class.
- <u>School Bussing:</u> Our lunchtime school bussing has now changed over so that students are picked up near their homes and delivered to school for 12:30pm (Blk 2 class starts at 12:45pm). Please check our most updated schedule: <u>New Mid-Day Bus Schedule for January 4th 29th</u>
- After Grad Parent Committee Meeting: The Claremont Parent After Grad Committee has established an executive committee and has started making plans for fundraising and potential grad events.
