Dear Parents, Guardians, and Students,

As we head into the final weekend in May (and with June right around the corner), please take a moment to read over some important information to be aware of, especially the recent health updates announced by the Province of BC and the Ministry of Education:

• Restart Plan - A Message from SD63 Superintendent Dave Eberwein: The province recently announced a new 4-step BC Restart Plan with implementation dates of May 25, June 15, July 1 and Sept 7. Moving through these 4 steps is dependent on the province continuing along the trajectory of fewer COVID infections and hospitalizations. The Ministry of Education and the Provincial Health Office have also provided school districts with clarity and specific directions for the remainder of this school year. Specifically, schools are to remain in our current Stage 2 configuration for the remainder of this school year and into the summer months. This means that all year-end school activities are expected to follow the current safety guidelines on things such as gatherings and cohort size limits.

As you are likely aware, we are currently planning for a return to Stage 1 in September which means a return to regular classes. We are expecting an announcement from the provincial government in late June with more details on any specifics for school operations in September. We thank you for your ongoing cooperation and understanding as we continue to make our schools safe places for students and staff. - <u>Lunchtime Bussing</u>: a reminder that starting Mon May 31st, lunchtime school busses will switch back to 'picking students up near their homes and then dropping them off at school' close to the end of lunch (12:30pm) so that they can attend their Block 2 class which will be full time attendance until the end of the school year.
- <u>Literacy / Numeracy Assessments</u>: The assessment schedule for Mon, June 14th to Wed., June 17th is linked <u>HERE</u>. These assessments only affect Grade 10 or 11 students that are scheduled in a Math or English class (or both) this Quarter; please double check the schedule and ensure that your child is aware of the date(s) and time(s) that they are writing. - <u>After Grad Parent Committee Meeting:</u> The next meeting for the Claremont Parent After Grad Committee is Tues. The Saanich School District uses the Microsoft TEAMs platform for many virtual meetings.
- <u>Access to Photos from Grads "Stage Crossing</u>": all those Grade 12 students that participated in one of the "Walk Across the Stage" film sessions on May 14/15/16 are now able to access their family Photo Booth pictures by logging onto the *Grad 2021 Google Classroom Page*. Grads will be able to click on a link to a Google Drive folder that is organized based on the specific day that they attended the walk through, and they can search through and then download their specific family photos. - Online Course Completion Deadline for Grads May 31: If you are applying to university/college, make sure you have completed any online courses (SIDES, NIDES, etc) by Monday May 31st. This deadline allows for sufficient time for coursework to be graded and final marks to be sent to the Ministry of Education for your transcript.
