Tuesday June 29th - Claremont GRAD DAY 2021 - Student "WALK THROUGH" Parade Overview An email to all Grads will be sent by June 11th outlining specifics for June 29th. for all For now be thinking about the following... Grads Make sure you have the day booked off work!! Unfortunately there will be no opportunity for parents/guardians to view the "Walk Through." This is a student and staff only event. You will arrive at Claremont and assemble around the track at set times, starting at 11:00 am in your Cohort in a set location You will be in a Cohort of 45 to 50 Grads, approximately 5 Cohorts You can be dressed up in the same or similar outfit you wore to cross the stage on filming day Wear comfortable walking shoes, heels on the grass are not ideal:) In 25 minute intervals each Cohort will "Walk Through" the school in a parade to honour you as a Grad. Staff will be along the parade route cheering Once you have completed your "Walk Through," each Grad will receive a 'Swag Bag" of gifts from the Parents. During the "Walk Through" a photo of all Grads on the field will be taken, masks will be required (this may happen at the mid way point...more details to follow) Music will be playing in the background, photo booth on site, and various locations assigned for photo opportunities At approximately 2:30 p.m. Grads will depart Claremont to UVic for the parent organized Car Parade.
