Dear Parents, Guardians and Students,

Although it is always nice to sit and have a conversation, we have discovered that this format has enabled a greater number of conversations to happen with phone calls and video chats. In the previous week's memo, two important concerns were raised: vandalism and "fight club." We thank families for taking the time to talk about these two very serious issues at home, because it has resulted in helpful information finding its way to Administration. As a result, we have worked with a number of students and parents to resolve some of these concerns and we are currently working on plans to "make it right" within our school community.

Our next request for families is to engage in conversations with your child about language. It has been reported that some students have been using derogatory and/or racist language in the school and on our school buses. This is a significant concern and is something we will not tolerate within our school community and/or our surrounding community. As before, we need your help to talk about this at home so we can ensure our school is a safe and inclusive place for all.
