Dear Parents, Guardians and Students.

On Monday, Jan. 31st we will begin semester two with our original schedule of **AM classes**, **Blocks 1,2,3,4**, **PM classes**. The Copernican schedule served our school community well this month when we headed out of winter break. It allowed us to slow the pace down in the school, make some adjustments in an effort to reduce student transitions (students with spares not in the building and designated break times), and focus on the continued importance of wearing masks. Our student absenteeism was relatively consistent over the weeks, and in comparison with neighboring schools, who remained on a four block schedule, we were all similar.

Administration received a range of feedback from Claremont students, staff and our District Executive on which direction to go with our schedule next week. The majority prefer a return to our four-block day, but would still like to see safety measures in place. We will see a return to some directional arrows in the hallways, continue to encourage students to eat lunch in classes and only provide a few tables in the hallways.

According to recent reports from the PHO and the BC Covid Dashboard, the number of daily cases reported are trending in a better direction. Sports teams will be given permission to participate in tournaments starting February 1, and there is also renewed optimism other restrictions may be lessened.

<u>Semester Two Daily Schedule</u>: After careful reflection of attendance data and student transition patterns these past few weeks, we will return to our 4-block per day semestered schedule with a few slight changes to the length of breaks between classes (6 mins) and the duration of lunch (35 mins).
