- Grade 12: Starting next Tuesday, grade 12 students who have not written their Numeracy 10 or Literacy 10 / 12 assessments will be able to sign up for one of three sessions on April 26th or 27th. These assessments are required for graduation; if possible, have a chat with your grad to see if they've completed them and, if necessary, remind them to sign up at the front office. ALL semester II grade 12 students who are currently enrolled in English 12 and AP will be writing the Literacy 12 assessment with their class.
- **Grade 10:** All grade 10 students in Foundations of Math Pre-Calculus will be writing the Numeracy 10 assessment with their class on either April 26th or 27th.
