- If I have 3 infractions, a letter will be sent home to my parents. If no change has been made, a meeting with the Principal, Program Coordinator and Instructor will be required to discuss the behaviour and re-evaluate my commitment to the program.
- I understand that completion of the entire program is expected, otherwise no credits will be earned and graduation could be in jeopardy.

Parents/Guardians agree to the following:

- I realize that attendance at school and transportation to and from the work experience job site are both vital.
- I understand that the program takes precedence over other activities ie: sports, jobs etc. These are secondary and are not to interfere with the program or work experience units.
- I realize some project-related tours and activities may take place during Pro-D days.
- I will purchase tools as requested by the program such as a tape measure, speed square, hammer and steel-toe boots).
- I am aware that the program will continue through until the end of June as required.
- I understand the risks associated with working in the trades and trust my child to make informed decisions and to follow all regulations.
- Prior to Work Experience placements, I will ensure Agreement Forms and Insurance (WCB) Forms are signed and submitted to the Instructor.
