What is plot?

- The plot is the chain of events that make up a story.
- Each link in the chain should help to build suspense and help to solve a problem.

There are 6 parts to plot:

- 1. Introduction
- 2. Initiating Incident
- 3. Rising Action
- 4. Climax
- 5. Falling Action
- 6. Conclusion

What is the purpose of the introduction?

- To provide background information on characters
- Sets up the basis for the story
- Sets the mood/tone
- to provide the setting

What is the initiating incident?

What is the rising action?

What is the climax

What is the falling action?

What is the purpose of a conclusion?

- The first point of conflict that activates the story
- All the events that build up the story should increase/intensify the conflict
- The most intense part of the story. It is the point where the conflict ends.
- All the events that follow the climax and they help to resolve the story.
- Provides closure
