

## ASSESSMENT CRITERIA FOR EVERYDAY WORK

<p><b>High (A)</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All parts of the task are completed</li> <li>• Powerful and complete understanding</li> <li>• Few, if any, corrections to be made</li> <li>• Displays creativity</li> <li>• Observes the conventions of sentence and paragraph structure</li> <li>• Thoughts are organized</li> <li>• Rich vocabulary is utilized</li> </ul>
<p><b>Average (B)</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All parts of the task are completed</li> <li>• Strong understanding and knowledge is evident</li> <li>• Some corrections are required</li> <li>• Some creativity is demonstrated</li> <li>• Few errors in sentence and paragraph structure</li> </ul>
<p><b>Acceptable (C)</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All parts of the task are completed</li> <li>• Competent at the knowledge level</li> <li>• Shows evidence of understanding but understanding may be limited to superficial details</li> <li>• Errors in sentence and paragraph structure occasionally impede meaning</li> <li>• Some use of slang or colloquial phrases</li> </ul>
<p><b>I (Incomplete)</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Task is not completed (100%) or is not accurate</li> <li>• Does not look presentable (ink smudges, doodles, words scribbled out...)</li> <li>• No name</li> <li>• Frequent errors in sentence and paragraph structure</li> <li>• Word choice is incorrect</li> <li>• Frequent use of slang or colloquial phrases (informal tone)</li> </ul>
