- 4. Administration Update Aaron Buckham
- School Plan Goal: "To promote a culture of care and inclusivity for all students, especially those who are new to our building and those at the margins." This is aligned with the District's Strategic Plan and Goals.
- Inquiry Questions Related to School Plan:
- What are the most effective and lasting methods of dismantling racism that will work for our school, and how can we best engage in meaningful reconciliation?
- In what ways can we foster a school culture that focuses on acceptance, empathy and understanding?
- Potential Fee Increase for CSI Programs:
- Many of our CSI programs are struggling to make ends meet due to rising costs of transportation (use of bus, gas cost, driver cost, etc). We are proposing that all fees across the board are raised a grand total of \$50 for the year per student, or an extra \$5 per month. If approved, this will begin in school year 2024/25. Approval requires three PAC members to sign off on a district form before Aaron can ask the Board to approve the increase.
