

Black Out Poem

Black out poetry is a form of found poetry where you create lines from the words found on a page. As you can see in the sample, you need to take a black pen or paint and “black out” the words you do not need.

Your task is to create a black out poem with the text provided in class (and posted on the class website). The title of your poem is “As he lay drowning”. You can use the word drowning literally or figuratively (ex: drowning in sorrow or drowning in love, etc...) Have fun!
