Required Coursework:

- At least two senior level art courses

Recommended Coursework:

a business elective (most architects are self-employed)

Project: Architecture Portfolio (to be completed by the end of grade 12)

- Your portfolio should demonstrate your design and artistic abilities. It must include photographs or high quality colour photocopies of 10 original pieces demonstrating artistic design.
- You may include any of the following:
 - O hand drawings
 - O paintings
 - O sculptures
 - O photography
 - O technical drawings
 - O computer graphics
 - O model making

<u>Note</u>: you will be required to submit this portfolio with many of your applications to schools of architecture. Pieces created in class are acceptable.
