**Most Law Schools require students to complete an undergraduate degree before applying.**

### **Required Coursework:**

- Law 12
- AP Language and Composition
- Criminology
- at least 2 senior level humanities electives (Comparative Civilization 12, English 12 First Peoples, First Nations 12, Geography 12, History 12, Literature 12, Psychology 11 or 12)

### **Other Requirements:**

- Must take a significant role during the Law 12 mock trial. Only students in good standing will be given a significant role.

**Pathway Exploration/Work Experience: 20 hours over 2 years.**

### **Examples:**

- job shadowing professionals in the field
- visiting a post-secondary institution with a Law School
- interviewing professionals in the field
- organizing guest speakers for Law
- organizing the mock trial
- attending and observing a trial at the law courts
