

Making your Production Plan for Woodworking

See the Senior table project on the website as an example of what is expected for your plan.

Requirements:

- 1) Your 1st page will have a title, your name, and image of your completed project.
- 2) Your plan will contain a cutting list – this is a table of dimensions, material, and quantity for all the pieces. For example:

Cutting List:

<u>Part</u>	<u>Quantity</u>	<u>Dimensions</u>	<u>Material</u>
Top	1	24" x 24" x 3/4"	Oak
Legs	4	2" x 2" x 18	Oak

3) Your plan will need to have step by step instructions to make the project. These instructions will need include at least 3 detail drawings of the process.

4) Your plan will need to be formatted properly and handed in in paper format.

Make sure your plan and drawings are your work. DO NOT copy a plan from a magazine or internet. Doing so will result in a mark of zero and you will be required to do it again in order to pass the course.

I recommend Google Sketchup for your drawings but there are many other software packages available to do your 3D drawings. The tutorial for Sketchup is in this folder on the website.
