Making your Production Plan for Woodworking

See the Senior table project on the website as an example of what is expected for your plan.

Requirements:

- 1) Your 1st page will have a title, your name, and image of your completed project.
- 2) Your plan will contain a cutting list this is a table of dimensions, material, and quantity for all the pieces. For example:

- 3) Your plan will need to have step by step instructions to make the project. These instructions will need include at least 3 detail drawings of the process.
- 4) Your plan will need to be formatted properly and handed in in paper format.

Make sure your plan and drawings are your work. DO NOT copy a plan from a magazine or internet. Doing so will result in a mark of zero and you will be required to do it again in order to pass the course.

I recommend Google Sketchup for your drawings but there are many other software packages available to do your 3D drawings. The tutorial for Sketchup is in this folder on the website.
