General Information

Athlete and Parent / Guardian Statements

Applicants, as well as their parent/guardians, are required to include a brief declaration in the application package outlining their reasons for application to the CSI Program on the forms provided.

Report Card

Students are required to include a copy of their most recent report card in the application package.

Program Costs

The base cost (not inclusive of field trips outside the CRD) for each of our CSI Programs are as follows:

Lacrosse: New Student Athlete = \$1350 (Returning Student Athlete = \$1200) Rowing: New Student Athlete = \$2450 (Returning Student Athlete = \$2175)

Swimming: Overall Cost = \$ 450 (Does not include the Island Swimming Fee)

Golf: Overall Cost = \$ 1250

This fee is related to the direct costs incurred that are in addition to the costs of providing a standard educational program, such as supplies and player equipment, athlete transportation, outside facility costs, and honorariums for guest coaches & instructors.

An initial deposit cheque of \$250.00 made out to School District #63 must be submitted / attached to each application: once a student receives written confirmation (by way of email, on or after March 16th) that they have been accepted into the CSI program, this initial deposit cheque will be cashed and the amount will be deducted from the total cost for their particular sport that is listed above. This initial deposit of \$250 is non-refundable and will only be cashed if the student is accepted into the CSI program.

NOTE:

Any families who do not use cheques, please **contact the Claremont accounts department before March 17th** (250-658-6672) in order to pass along your credit card information or arrange an online payment so that payment can be made upon confirmation of acceptance into the program. Students will not gain acceptance into the CSI program without some form of initial deposit payment information on file.

The balance of the CSI program payment is due by September 30, 2023 in full or with post-dated cheques until full payment is received. Please contact the Claremont Principal, Mr. Aaron Buckham, if you would like more information regarding fees and/or hardship. CSI is a program of choice and fees are required. All conversations are strictly confidential.

Athletic Eligibility

BC School Sports continues to recognize the right of all students to choose which school they attend and which subjects they study. Please ensure you stay informed on the new changes and the impacts on student athletes, especially prior to entering their grade 9 year (1st year of eligibility). If there are more applicants than space permits for a particular program, admission will be based on the overall strength of each application and student may be added to a waitlist. For all applications, references may be contacted and applicants may be interviewed.
