## Welcome to Meet the Teacher, Thursday September 23, 2021

For many parent/guardians it has been a while since you have had the opportunity to be inside Claremont. We are looking forward to opening our doors for this and seeing some of you in the building. We will be breaking this evening into two portions. The first will be a short presentation with your Admin team in the gym and will have a limited capacity of 150 in attendance from 5:30 - 5:50 pm. The second will be an opportunity for parents/guardians to move through their child's timetable from 6:00 - 8:00 pm.

To enter the building you **must be in good health and wear at mask at all times.** Please remember to have a copy of your child's timetable or take a photo of it on your phone and speak to them about location of their classrooms. We will have signage posted and helpers to direct you if needed.

At 5:30 pm the Claremont Admin Team will meet those parents of grade 9 or 10 students who feel comfortable entering the gym for a brief presentation. We are asking only one parent/guardian per family. If you wish to attend this session please sign up using this <u>LINK</u> as we are required to collect names and contact info of those who enter the building. The first 150 to sign up will be the maximum for this event after which point the link will close. If you are not able to join us for this portion we encourage you to still come and meet your student's teachers for the rest of the evening.

At 6:00 pm, parent/guardian (one per family) from all grade levels are welcome to meet their child's teacher following the schedule below. Health and Safety requires that parents and/or community members who enter our building or classroom must register their name and contact information and only come if feeling healthy. In addition there will be a capacity limit of 14 visitors per room. In the event there are more than 14 visitors, the 20 minute blocks of time will be split into two ten minute visits with the teacher. Those in the second half will remain out in the hallway and will be invited into the classroom once the first session is complete. The purpose of this night is for teachers to share a brief course overview, identify most effective means of communication, and to answer general questions. Parent and guardians who want specific information about their child will need to arrange a separate appointment with the teacher. School Map.
