Graffiti on School Grounds: It is with frustration that we bring to everyone's attention a situation that happened in the early hours of Saturday Feb. 26th. Claremont school grounds (parking lots & Track) and building was hit with some nasty Graffiti. Latex interior house paint and a 6" paint brush was used to cause this vandalism that included the "F" word and a homophobic slur. Thankfully our neighbours alerted school Administration and our Ground Crew was able to pressure wash the paint away before our students arrived Monday morning. The Saanich Police have opened a file and we are seeking any information about who is responsible. We take pride in our school and need everyone to feel safe and respected in our community.
